Today Afternoon, enjoy an exclusive safari at Minneriya National Park.

This park acts as a breeding ground to the surrounding jungles during the dry season. The unique phenomenon of elephant gathering during the dry season from June to September could not be sighted at one place, anywhere else in the world! It's recorded that elephants gathered here are numbered around 150-200. Some reports account the number of elephants to as high as 700.

Day 02:

SIGIRIYA / KANDY

After an Early Breakfast, visit the **Sigiriya Rock Fortress (Lion's Rock),** one of the most extraordinary artistic complexes of its time (477–498 AD). This magnificent citadel, declared as a UNESCO heritage site in 1982, allures artistic and architectural curiosity from around the globe.

Return to the hotel.

Later proceed to Kandy. (Approximate drive duration 02 ¹/₂ hours)

En-route visit a Spice Garden in Matale.

Arrive and check-in to the hotel & relax.

In the Late Afternoon visit the **Temple of the Tooth Relic**.

Kandy became home to the Tooth Relic of the Buddha which symbolizes a 4th century tradition that links royalty with being the protector of the Tooth. The Sacred Tooth Relic of the Buddha was brought to Sri Lanka in the 4th century. Often referred to as the palladium of the Sinhala kings, it was protected and venerated by the King who built a temple for it within the royal palace. The building which housed the Sacred Tooth Relic of Buddha was always considered an extremely important edifice and was thus located next to the palace.

After an Early Breakfast, you will be transferred to Kandy railway station for your train ride. (Train Time 8.48am. Podi Menike)

Day 04: NUWARAELIYA / NEGOMBO Breakfast & Dinner

In the Morning, Visit a **Tea factory**. Here you will find out how the high quality tea is produced and you may end up enjoying a steamy hot cup of Tea. Don't forget to grab a few fresh tea packets on your way out.

Later Proceed to Negombo. (Approximate drive duration 05 hours)

Evening Explore Negombo.

Negombo is a city on the west coast of Sri Lanka, north of the capital, Colombo. Near the waterfront, the remains of the 17th-century Dutch Fort now house a prison. Negombo Lagoon, lined with fishermen's huts, feeds into the Dutch-era Hamilton Canal. The canal leads south to Colombo. Neoclassical St. Mary's Church, completed in the 1920s, features a ceiling decorated with vivid religious paintings.
