## ITINERARY

**DAY 1: Arrive to Casablanca airport**

Upon landing at Casablanca Airport, you'll be greeted by your driver and then transferred to your hotel. Check-in and Overnight.

**DAY 2: Casablanca – Rabat – Fes (294Km, 4 hours drive)**

Start your sightseeing tour of Casablanca. Visit of Hassan II Mosque. The Mosque is a stunning monument a marvel of architecture Arabo-Muslim. Continue the visit with Ain Diab corniche with a chance to visit the shopping Center « Morocco mall ». Visit of the Habbous, the old medina of Casablanca and quick stop at Mohamed V square.

Drive to Rabat, The capital of Morocco. Lunch at leisure and then start a sightseeing tour of the main monuments. Visit of Kasbah Oudaya, Chellah, Hassan Tower and Mohamed V mausoleum. Drive to Fes. Arrive, check-in and overnight at your hotel.

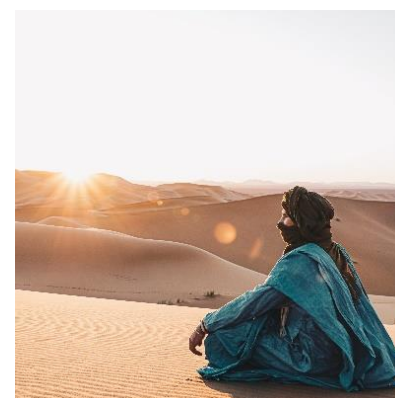
**DAY 3: Fes**

After breakfast, the whole day will be devoted to discovering Fes, the oldest of the Imperial Cities, which is well known for its spiritual and educational contributions to the Moroccan culture.

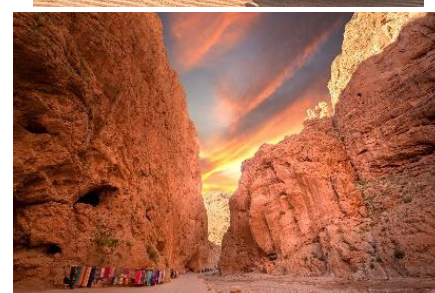
Visit of the medieval Medina. You will also explore the famous souks where craftsmen still labour in the age-old oriental tradition. Lunch at leisure. In the afternoon, Visit of the new city “Fes Jdid”.

**DAY 4: Fes to Merzouga (414Km, 7 hour drive)**

Breakfast at hotel – Early departure to Merzouga via Errachidia and Midelt. Visit of Ifrane and Azrou cedar forests on the way. Arrive to Erfoud and switch vehicles to 4x4s for your transfer to the camp in Merzouga desert. Enjoy the trip. Admire the sunset during a camel ride. Check-in and overnight at your camp.

**DAY 5: Merzouga to Ouarzazate (314Km, 5 hours drive)**

Breakfast at the camp – departure to Ouarzazate via Tinghir. Visit of the spectacular Gorges of Todra, canyon in the eastern part of the High Atlas. Drive through Dades valley, passing by Kalaa M’Gouna (capital of roses). Continue to reach Ouarzazate – Arrive, check-in and overnight



**DAY 6: Ouarzazate – Ait Benhaddou – Marrakech (193Km, 4h drive)**

Breakfast at hotel – Visit of Kasbah Taourirt and Atlas cinema studio where many Hollywood films were made (Optional). Drive to Ait Benhaddou and visit of Ait Benhadou Kasbah 30 km far from Ouarzazate. It is the most spectacular fortress in the south of Morocco, used as decors for many films as well like the “Lawrence of Arabia”.

The fortified village of Aït Benhaddou has been classified by UNESCO as one of the world’s cultural treasures. It is studded with crenulated towers and its buildings decorated with geometrical motifs and considered to be one of the most beautiful villages of this kind in Morocco. Departure to Marrakech via a long mountainous road and the Tizi n’tichka Pass, the highest pass in Morocco. Arrive, check-in and overnight at your hotel.



**DAY 7: Marrakech**

Breakfast on board – You will start a historical visit of the principal monuments of Marrakech known as “The Pearl of South”. You will visit the famous Koutoubia, a demonstration of Hispano-Moorish art that has a 70m minaret; it’s an architectural masterpiece showing the remarkable design of the period. The Bahia palace decorated with exceptional cedar wood.

Later visit of the Souks sources of temptations, regrouping different works and business: Cabinetmakers, ironware merchants, boiler makers. Then the visit continues to the famous Jamâa El fna square known to be a place of public execution until last century. Today it provides constant ever-changing entertainment, which is more alive in the sunset and continues late in the night. The square is centre for public meetings and even riots, where story tellers, snake charmers, acrobats, folkloric bands, etc... are operating daily.



**DAY 8: Departure**

Breakfast at hotel - transfer to Marrakech Airport for your final departure.
